TIPS FOR ENTERING

Before you start

- Visit www.cahsc-cornwall.org.uk/care-and-support-awards-2019 to find out more about the awards and read about the individual categories.
- **Think carefully about which category to enter.** If you're not sure which one is right for you, read the awards category information on the website to see which one is best suited to who you want to nominate! Remember you can enter nominations for more than one category, you just need to complete a separate nomination form for each entry.

Completing your entry

- **What makes the individual, team or organisation the best?** The Awards are about recognising and celebrating the best of the best! Make sure you use your nomination as an opportunity to demonstrate why your nominee is the best at what they do.
- **Describe and share the extraordinary.** Tell us specifically what they are doing differently or innovatively and what the impact has been.
- **Don't make assumptions.** The judges might not know anything about the individual, team or organisation, so be sure to tell their story.
- **Don't forget to mention the obvious!** You need to include the basics and other things which you may take for granted. Remember the judges can only go on what is in the entry.

Amending your details or your entry.
